Sexual and Reproductive Health Profiles

Sexual health is a significant part of health and wellbeing Being able to have conversations about sexual health is impo

reduce the incidence of sexually transmitted infections (STIs) including HIV & promote the uptake of STI screening & treatment.

**STIs are infections** spread by unprotected sex or sexual contact. Anyone can get an STI & many people do not have symptoms, so it is important to have regular testing. Condoms can help prevent STIs from passing from one person to another.

**Early detection & treatment** reduces the spread of infection & can minimise the impact of serious long term health complications.

**Early access to HIV treatment** significantly reduces the risk of HIV transmission to an uninfected person.

**Contraceptive information & services** are fundamental to the health & human rights of individuals.

**To help the prevention of unintended pregnancies and the reduction in teenage pregnancies it** is important for professionals to have a clear overview of contraceptive choices available & to feel confident to introduce & discuss contraception (including emergency contraception).

**Long-acting reversible contraception (LARC)** are extremely reliable methods of contraception to prevent a pregnancy. Once inserted there is no need to remember to take contraception every day. **LARC** methods include the implant, injection, hormonal coil (IUS) & non hormonal coil (IUD).

**Condoms** - are the only method of contraception that can protect against both unintended pregnancy & some sexually transmitted infections.

**axess sexual health** is a free sexual health service for Warrington, Halton, Knowsley, Liverpool & Cheshire East. General clinics are inclusive to everybody including young people 19 & under.

**axess 4 u** is our sexual health clinic for young people (aged 19 & under). This clinic is a walk-in, meaning you don't need an appointment to be seen by our healthcare staff.
