We're building a suite of accessible e-Learning courses and finding other creative ways to share key messages, supporting *all* learning across the whole partnership.

Based on feedback from our Learning Week, we know many of you found the accessibility of the Teams short session automatic invites dropped into calendars extremely helpful. We're therefore introducing monthly Teams 'drop in' webinars for up to an hour at midday where there is no need to book, just join us if you find the topic interesting and relevant, or simply delete if not!
